THE FRENCH PLATFORM FOR THE GLOBAL DEAL

After the French accession to the Global Deal initiative on 17 November 2017 at the Gothenburg Social Summit, Minister of Labour Muriel Pénicaud launched the French platform on 21 December 2017 in Paris.

Today, more than **30 partners** have joined the platform.




